### 2025 School Bus Service Expressions of Interest Opening Soon

Dear Families,

As we plan ahead for 2025, we're excited to announce that expressions of interest for our school bus service will soon be open. Our bus service operates daily, providing convenient transportation for students from home to school and back. This is a user-pay service, with costs set at \$4 per trip, billed annually.

For families considering this service, please be aware of the following key guidelines:

- Staffing: Each bus is staffed with a driver and a bus assistant to ensure student safety and support during the journey.
- **Student Behaviour:** We expect all students to travel safely and respectfully. If any issues arise, the school will work with families and staff to develop strategies to support appropriate behavior.
- Service Selection: In the event that there are more requests than available spots, priority will be given to students with full-time placements. The selection process will be at the discretion of the school principal and communicated in consultation with parents.
- New Junior Class Students: Please note that students beginning in the Junior Class will not be eligible for the bus service until Semester 2, or after a prior assessment by our Allied Health Team.

We encourage families to submit their bus service requests early to help us effectively plan for 2025. Be sure to complete the upcoming expression of interest form, and provide any additional information about your child's travel needs or alternative addresses, if applicable.

The process for booking a bus service has changed slightly and we will share this information with families very soon (through SeeSaw). If you have any questions or require assistance, please don't hesitate to contact the school office.

We look forward to continuing to support our school community with safe and reliable transportation in 2025!
